Welcome to Information Processing! A boring name for a fun class where you can learn to do anything you want to do with computers - From keyboarding to digital video production or 3D animation!

The difference between the **A** and the **C** designation is only time. The **A** means a **3 credit**, or quarter-semester course, while a **C** means you are in a **5 credit** full semester course.

A final mark will be determined for each completed module. There is no “average” mark for this class, but rather the individual module marks are reported. Failures are recorded, but are not reported to Alberta Education or averaged with other marks.
